# Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Resilience in Educational Contexts

## OBJECTIVES

- To build the capacity of educators, practitioners and policy makers to promote and nurture the resilience and wellbeing of children and young people from vulnerable and marginalised and adverse backgrounds
  - through a systemic, interdisciplinary, cross cultural approach
  - at practice, policy and research levels

# Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Resilience in Educational Contexts

## FEATURES

- First European Master Programme in Resilience in Education
- Awarded by 4 European Universities and supported by 5 Associated Partners
- 4 different mobilities in at least 3 different Universities
- Integrates taught courses, practice placement, and dissertation
- Led by a team of international experts on resilience in education

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## PROGRAMME AND STUDENTS

- 2 Years full time
- 4 different cohorts over 5 years (2023-2028)
- 72 scholarships (partners, programme, targeted) and 52 self-funded places
- 30 students per cohort (18 scholarships, 12 self-funded)

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## CURRENT EDITIONS

- First edition started in October 2023: 18 scholarship candidates from 16 countries
- **Second edition starting in October 2024: 18 scholarship candidates from 16 countries and 3 self-funding students**
- Self-funding registration fees reduced substantially; applications close 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024
- **Scholarship applications for 3<sup>rd</sup> edition open 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024**

# Student Mobility



- Students need to make 3 face to face mobilities in at least 3 different universities, with the 1<sup>st</sup> semester being at the University of Malta; 2<sup>nd</sup> semester University of Crete and 3<sup>rd</sup> semester University of Lisbon/Stefan Cel Mare University Suceava
- In the 4<sup>th</sup> semester course participants may follow their studies online, face to face, or blended in any of the four awarding universities subject to availability
- An optional one week summer school (Europe)

EMJM FLOURISH seeks to develop the requisite personal and professional resilience competences to enhance course participants' career prospects in various areas:

- **Education policy development**
- **Consultation and training**
- **Mental health promotion**
- **Social work and community development**
